What is it?

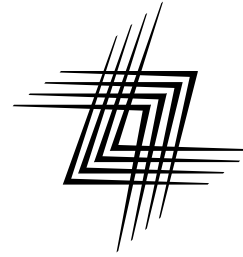
The Lieutenant Governor's Leadership Forum brings together 18 Saskatchewan youth in grades 11 and 12 who have demonstrated outstanding leadership abilities in their schools and communities. Over 10 unforgettable days, these students get to travel the province; meet successful people



from government, business, the arts, science, athletics, the nonprofit sector, media, academia, military, and law enforcement; and take part in a variety of experiences designed to strengthen the mind, body, and their leadership potential.

This year's Forum will take place October 13-24. Participants will spend four days in Saskatoon, four days in Regina, and two days in La Ronge. Upon completing the program, they will receive a **30-level Special Project Credit** toward their high school graduation requirements and a certificate of participation in the physical activity/fitness component.

Any Saskatchewan high school student who will be in Grades 11 or 12 in October 2008 and has demonstrated exceptional leadership abilities is encouraged to apply.

Selection criteria will include:

1. Leadership in school activities
2. Leadership in the community
3. Academic achievement
4. Essay outlining leadership in school and the community
5. Accomplishments, recognition, awards, honours, and scholarships



Eighteen applicants will be selected. Participants will be chaperoned and are expected to devote their time to Forum activities while the Forum is in session. All expenses for travel, food, and lodging will be covered.

Applications must be postmarked by Friday May 2, 2008.
